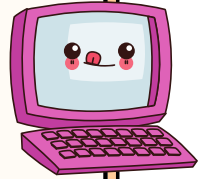

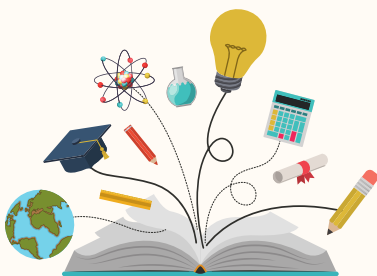
Information
