Curriculum

Our Design and Technology (D&T) lessons follow and cover all aspects of the National Curriculum, utilising the Twinkl scheme of work. Our D&T curriculum has been mapped out to ensure that our pupils experience a range of aspects to enable them to explore a variety of skills that will equip them for the future. All projects include the three types of activity: Investigative and Evaluative Activities, where children learn from a range of existing products and find out about D&T in the wider world. Focused Tasks where they are taught specific technical knowledge, designing skills and making skills. Design, Make and Evaluate Assignment where children create functional products with users and purposes in mind.

Small Steps Guide

When planning a DT unit please follow these steps.

- 1 Follow the agreed Brookfield Park Long Term Curriculum Plan
- 2 Familiarise yourself where your current unit fits in with the Long Term Plan and make relevant links in your first lesson to previous learning if possible.
- 3 Look at the resources before you plan your topic (if you need any new materials let me know so that we can look to order them).
- 4 Use DT books to show your progression:
Starting knowledge, resources used, pictures of lessons, how have you adapted for different abilities? 2 Higher, 2 Middle, 2 Lower ability as evidence.
- 6 Assessment. Use Twinkl assessment trackers for each topic to assess children's skill progression for each aspect set.
