### Headteacher Update

It was great to welcome back all of the children this week. Rehearsals for the KS2 show are well underway and it is shaping up to be another great show full of our talented children. Children have been told about the trip we have organised for Y5 and 6 as a replacement for the trip to Belgium. We will look at year 4 next year to provide a replacement trip for them as they were also promised the Disneyland trip. Thankyou for your patience in letting us sort it all out.

If you're clearing wardrobes for summer please remember to donate any uniform items you no longer need to Midstream, via the collection box outside the main entrance. This allows our families to pick up an absolute bargain and helps the learners at midstream to learn about running a business.

We need parents help with a recent trend we have noticed. A lot of children are bringing in things from home such as stuffed animals, squidgy and fiddly toys etc. This has never been permitted and children will be asked to put them in their bags and take them home. The reason for this is because they cause disruption to learning in many ways and we can't be sure of the safety of these toys. We have some children with a medical diagnosis or identified need which mean they require specific sensory equipment or comfort items. This is discussed and agreed with parents and where possible provided by school so we can ensure the safety particularly of sensory items being used. We are particularly concerned about some of the squidgy toys coming in as pupils have been putting them in their mouths and they are full of potentially toxic chemicals. Please talk to your children about leaving these things at home and if your child has a diagnosed need and requires access to a sensory based toy please make an appointment to discuss their medical needs with the class teacher who will pass on information to the SENCo. Thankyou for your support in this.

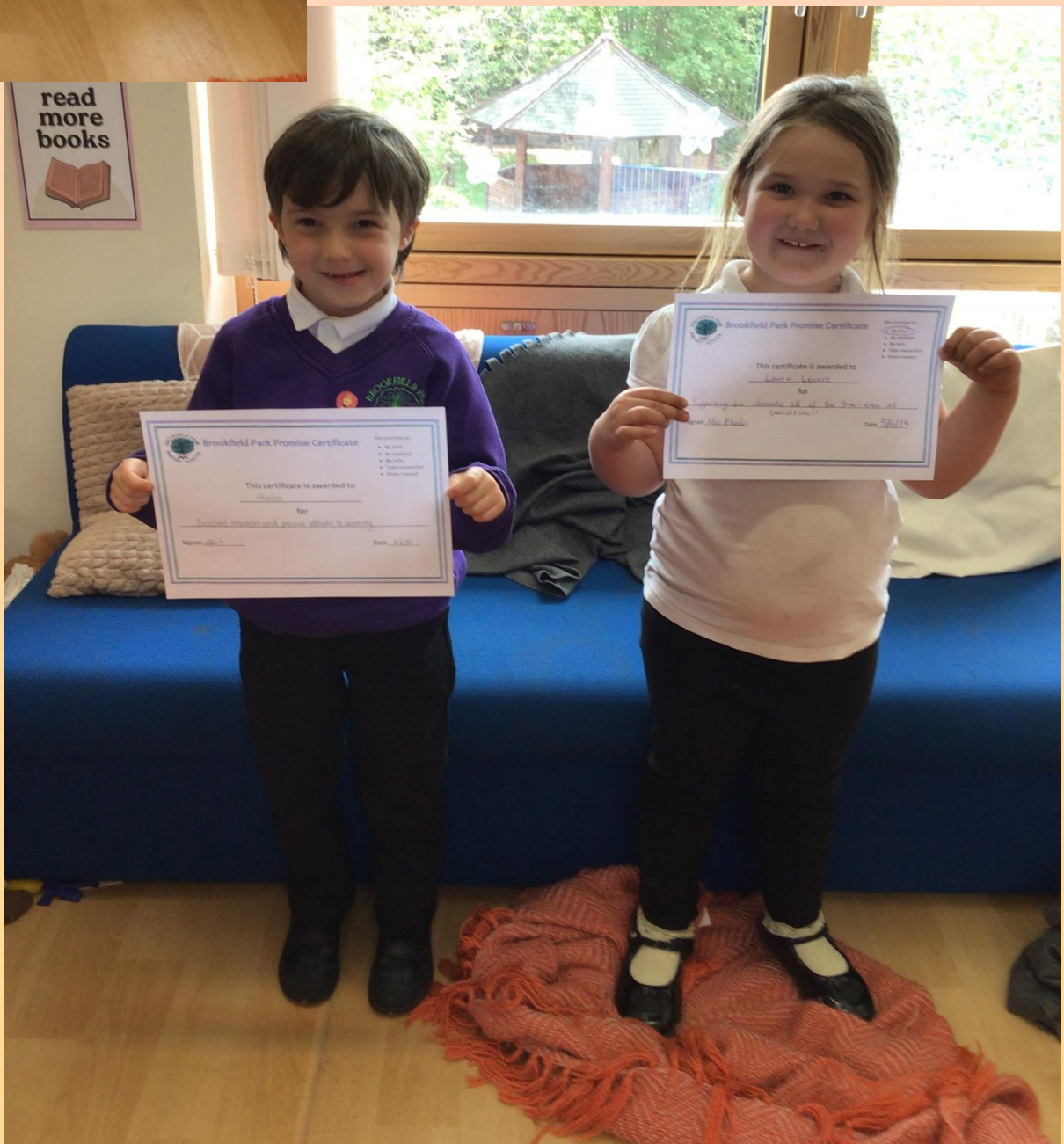

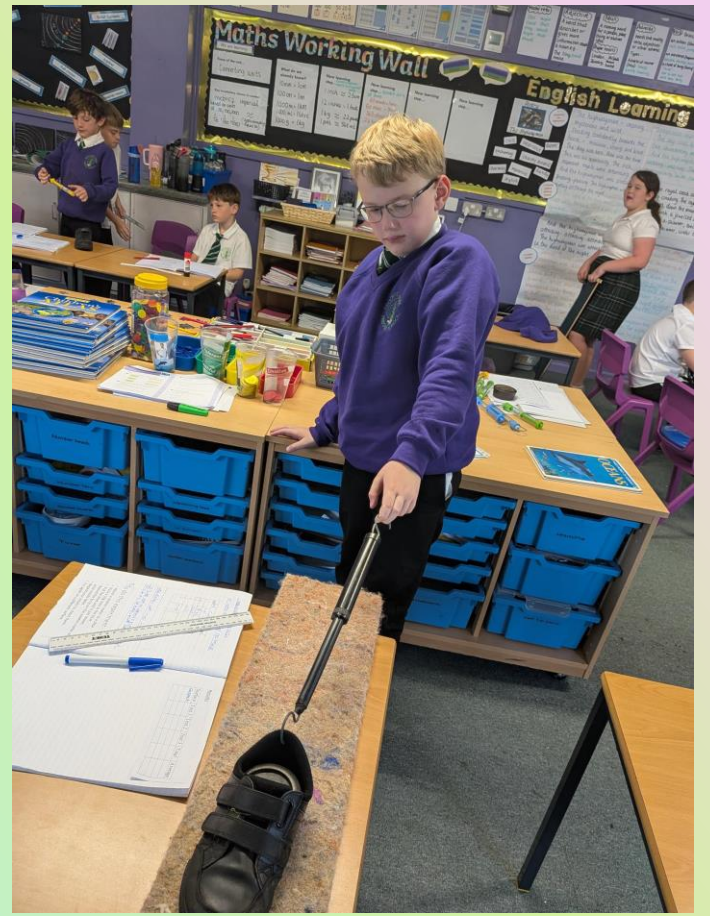




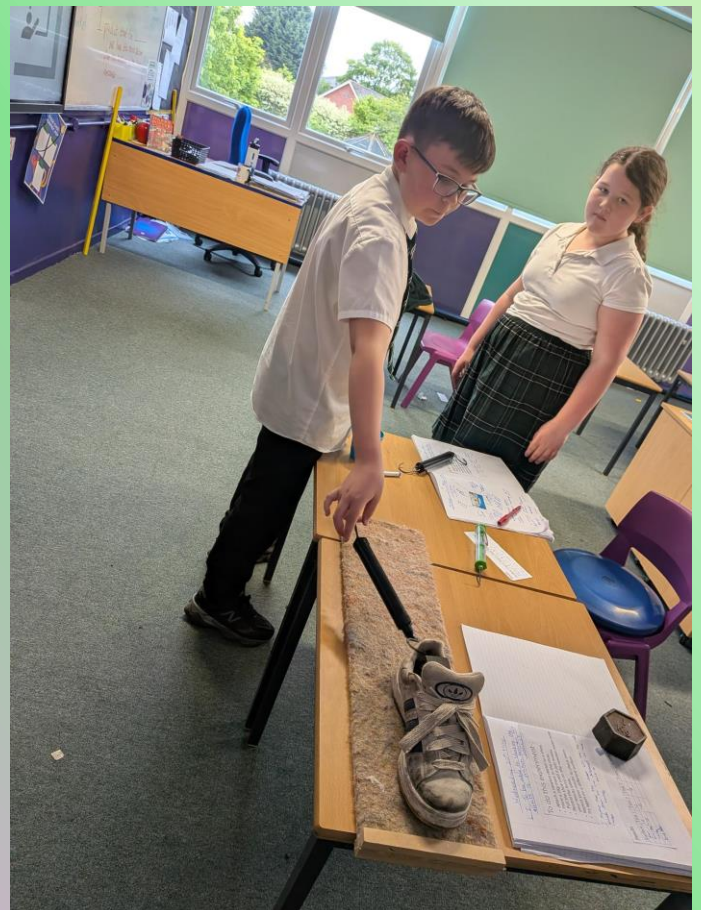
Year 1 and 2 got together to share their certificates this week as KS2 were in the hall practicing. KS2 will be getting certificates in individual classes
