Headteacher Update

As we head through the summer term, I wanted to take a moment to reflect on the past few weeks and share some important updates with you all.

The recent hot weather has thrown up some real challenges, and I'm genuinely grateful to our parents and carers for continuing to get the children to school despite these difficult conditions. Your commitment to their education really does make a difference. I must also say a huge thank you to our staff, who have been incredibly creative in adapting their teaching to keep our pupils engaged and supported throughout the heatwave. It's been really heartening to see the older children working alongside the younger ones whilst sharing their classrooms. The care and responsibility they've shown has been brilliant, and they've been outstanding role models for our younger pupils.

Looking ahead, the weather should hopefully settle down next week, which will let us get back to our normal routines and outdoor activities. I'd like to remind parents to make sure their children have good sun protection though – suncream and hats – as we continue to enjoy the summer months.

We're really looking forward to welcoming families to Edgehill for our sports day on Monday. It's always a highlight of the school calendar, and the children absolutely love the chance to do athletics on a real track. These events often help pupils discover new talents and build their confidence in competitive sport.

On a really positive note, I'm delighted to share that our Key Stage 1 pupils have done brilliantly in their phonics checks. We're particularly proud that 82% of our Year 1 children have successfully passed their check. That's a significant achievement and shows the hard work of both our pupils and staff in supporting their early reading skills.

Finally, a few upcoming events and deadlines to mention. Our summer fair is next Friday at 2pm, and school will close at 2pm that day so families can attend. We'd love to see lots of you there.
