Staff as always have spent lots of time making their classrooms look fabulous for the children's return



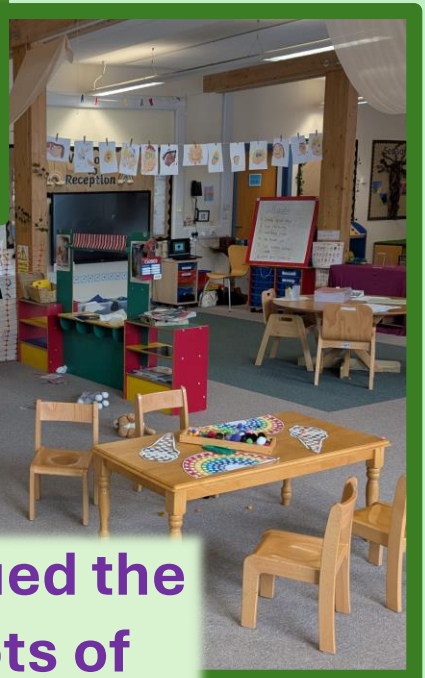
# EYFS have created 3 lovely learning spaces
