Autumn learning is well under way for the Nursery children

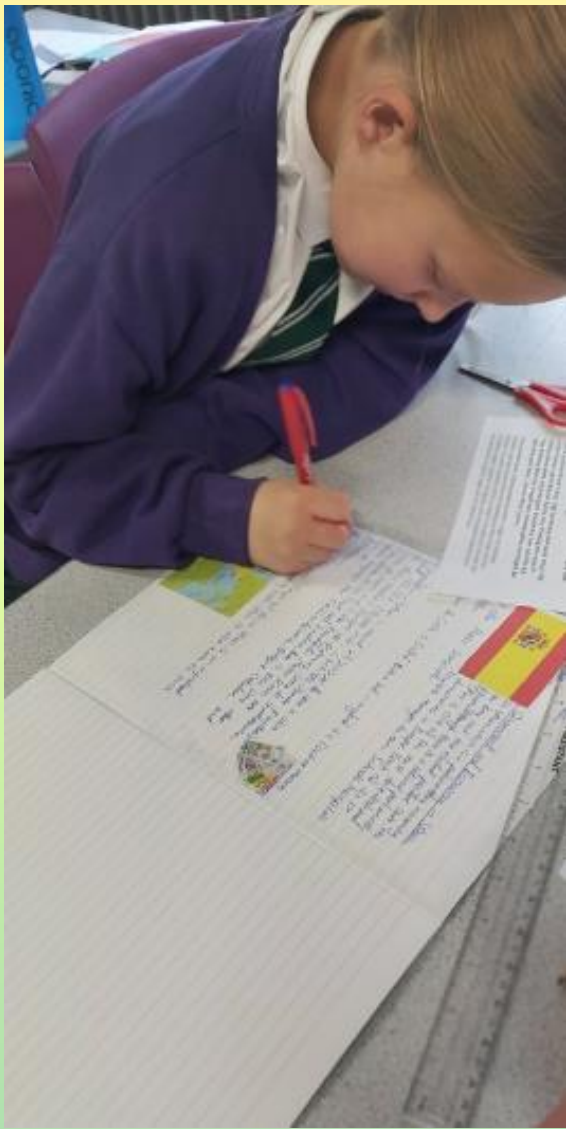


We have had lots of fun this week observing the changes outdoors.
