






Attendance

World Book Day in The Acorns. Year 4 illustrated different book characters for us to look at and we read stories together.







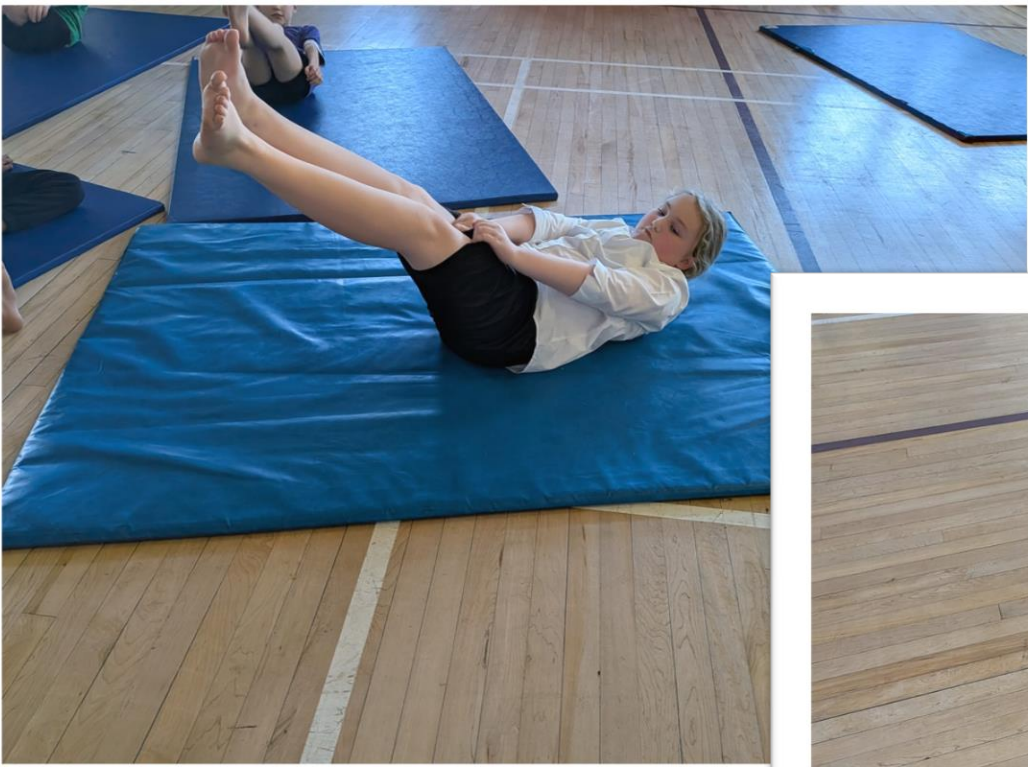


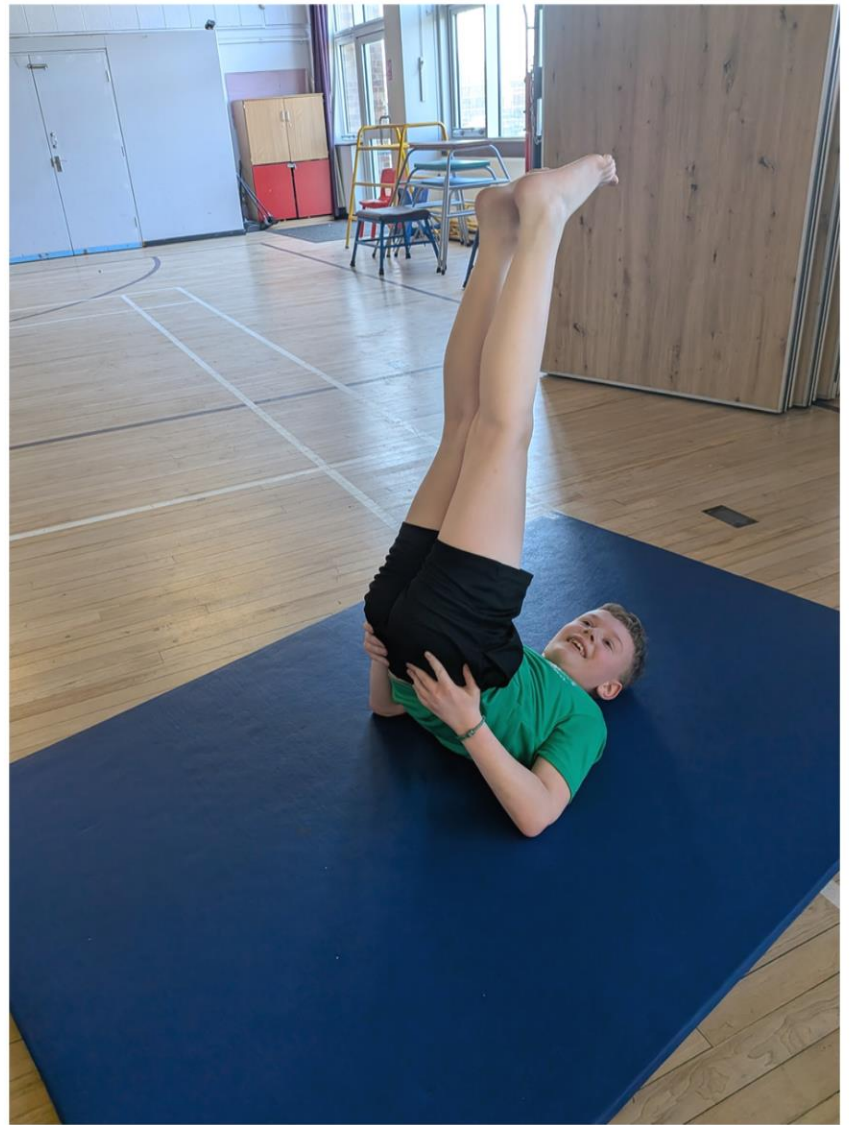


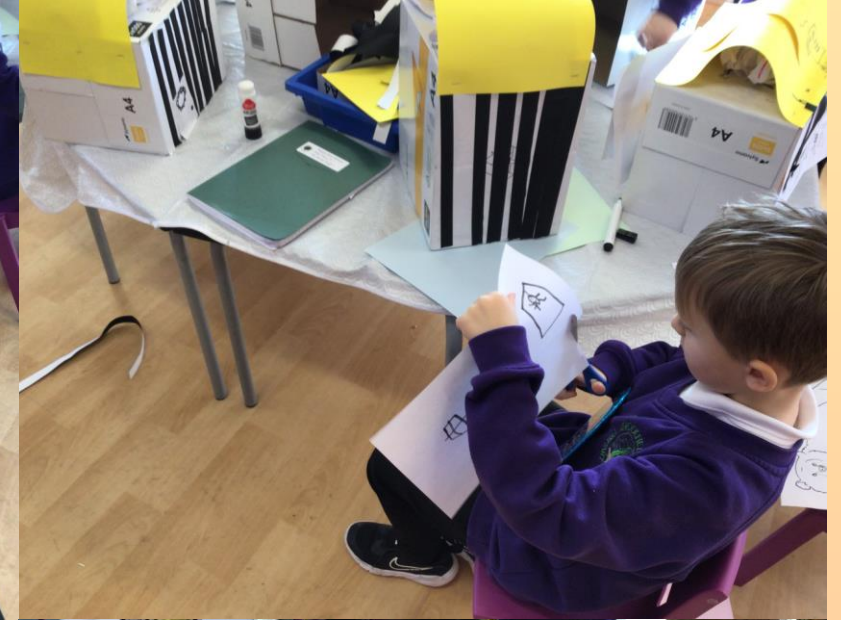
